How to use / Tips for using the library

All books and journals that are available can be looked up in the online catalogue.

Journals are arranged in alphabetical order. The latest issues are on display in the middle room; older unbound issues are in the boxes behind them. Volumes before 1960 are stored in the basement. A complete journal list is on display on top of the card catalogue in the middle room.

Maps are stored in locked cabinets. Please ask the librarian or student assistant.

Monographs are arranged in classified order. The classification list is on display on top of the card catalogue.

Monographs of the Geological Institute edited before 1974 and all theses (diploma and doctoral) are stored in the basement.

Extracted papers are also stored in the basement.

Reference materials (all of shelf number HB and text books for students marked with red tape) are not for loan.

To borrow books (authorized users only) complete a charge slip/request form.

The uppermost (white) sheet is for the library office.

The first (green) copy is put in a green plastic dummy in place of the book.

The second (yellow) copy is for you as a reminder of the loan period.

The loan period is 4 weeks.

For ordering books from the basement also use a request form.
